Emma has 11 years of experience in multi-hazard emergency management and continuity planning. Emma currently serves as the director of emergency management at [Portland State University](#) (PSU). She leads emergency planning and disaster preparedness efforts for the campus, coordinates the PSU Incident Management Team and Emergency Notification System, and assists departments with response and continuity planning.

Prior to joining PSU, Emma was planning coordinator with the Regional Disaster Preparedness Organization, a five-county consortium in the Portland, Oregon metro area. Her portfolio includes regional fuel contingency planning, updating the FEMA-compliant Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment report, and regional disaster debris planning.
